## How to clean the fridge (A take home assignment)

### Step #1:

- Fill up sink with hot soapy water
- Have a garbage bag ready beside you to throw out spoiled food

#### **Step #2:**

- Take all food out of the fridge
- Wipe down shelves (rinse cloth often!)
- · Wipe down inside walls of fridge
- Take out drawers and wash in the sink
- Wipe down inside door shelves
- Use HOT soapy water to soak off sticky messes
- Use a scrub or Eraser pad to remove stubborn stain

### Step #3

- Wipe the outside container of food
- · Put all the food back neatly and orderly into the fridge
- Make sure all meat products, except luncheon meat, are put on the bottom shelf of the fridge in leak proof containers/ packages
- Cheeses usually go in drawer
- Eggs are best in paper or foam containers
- Vegetables in one crisp drawer and fruit in another crisp drawer

#### Step #4

- Clean the outside of fridge
- Take out garbage (spoiled food going the food scrap bin and dirty packages should go to the garbage)
- Wash and dry re-usable containers. Store in appropriate places
- Empty water from sink, wash dirty dishcloth, wipe and clean your work area

#### Step #5


