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There are ways to combine two things to tell you the detail....

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
## Reading Symbols with your group members....

Look through the cloth from 3 different outfits (ie T-shirt, jeans, and jacket)

Name the type of clothing, draw the symbols given in the first two column and decode the meaning for each label.

Type of cloth	Symbols present on that clothing label	Meanings of those symbols
<p><i>Example:</i></p> <p><i>T-Shirt</i></p>		<p><i>Can be washed in warm water (30 C)</i></p> <p><i>Don't bleach this</i></p> <p><i>Ok in the dyer</i></p> <p><i>Use low heat when ironing</i></p> <p><i>Do not sent to dry cleaning</i></p>

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		<p>Hand wash in cold water            Do not Iron            Do not bleach            Drip dry</p>
		<p>Wash in warm water            Iron with medium heat setting            Do not wring            Dry flat</p>
		<p>Tumble dry without heat setting            Hang dry in the shade            Do not iron with steam on            Safe to dry clean</p>
